

Introduction of Móra Ferenc Primary School



The principal educational goals of Móra Ferenc Primary School has been determined in the educational program:

- Open-minded service, general education
- consciously organized educational activity
- preparing students for lifelong learning
- informed, creative, problem-solving students and active citizens
- orientation to nature and the environment, society, law and economy
- responsibility for their personal or collective actions
- becoming European citizen with Hungarian mind



Quality Improvement

In Europe and also in Hungary the efficiency and the quality of education has become the central issue. Our school participates in the quality improvement program of Public Education. Owing to the implement of the I. institutional model „partnership-oriented operation” and the II. model „comprehensive quality management”, we identified with the directives of system approach and continuously renewable work. At the end of the program our school was awarded for the comprehensive quality management.



Preventive-Corrective Pedagogical Approach

The last few years the number of those children who have learning and behavioral problems, was increased. 15 years ago, creating the required material and human resources our teacher staff undertook the education of those children in the scope of small classes. 10 years ago the Development Working Community was formed that aim is to filter those children who have learning difficulties. To compensate these disadvantages they have



also created an internal social network. Secret of their success lies in the fact that they are working in close cooperation with Sunflower Child Welfare Center and Family Support Service, Educational Counselling Service and last but not least, the parents.

Elf Academy

One of our principal goals is to help the transition between pre-school and primary school. Preparatory sessions are organized in our school to improve preschool children's complex skills during the school year.

The Complex Development of Competencies

Using the tools of the drama pedagogy have a long tradition in our school. With the help of the actors/drama teachers of Káva Cultural Center we complete(d) the educational , self-improvement process . These activities involve situational tasks, role-plays, the students become „artists” thus acquire practical skills. Our cooperation with Kolibri Theatre serves the same purpose. The pupils face with different life situations, problems that are discussed and solved together in a drama session right after the play. The creative collaboration of With Sunflower Child Welfare Center and Family Support Service has been developed for more than 15 years. At present the following preventive, complex development programs are



running : „Hidden Values” and „It is about you!” The Rex Club also plays in an important role in the prevention of „straggling”, where the children may get acquainted with new games, delicious recipes or just have a good chat with their skilled experts. We are truly proud of our gomoku-champions who owe much to the Rex Club.

Relationship with Parents



The School of Parents' (2003-2010) aim was to activate the cooperation between families and teachers to make children more successful. Parents (grandparents, siblings and anyone who may be involved in the education) have participated in intense discussions, intimate conversations with skilled experts who have answered their questions.

The Booklets of Móra (started in 2008) contain short articles that are easy to understand. Our goal was to make available our help at their homes, too. Up to now 8 booklets have been published. (One of them is a double booklet.)

Traditions in Móra



One of the oldest form of learning in our school is „Forest school” that is held in different landscapes of our fabulous native land. During the school camp the pupils visit the natural beauties, buildings and other spectacles of Hungary.

We commemorate the Day of the Folktale, take part in the St. Michael's Parish Feast, the Christmas Festival (with our Nativity play and Christmas carol singers).

Our repetitive projects are: the Hungarian Conquest and the Vintage. During the Daycare we regularly organize arts and crafts-afternoon. The international runic writing competition has been organised by Forrai Sándor Runic Coterie in Móra for 11 years.



International Relations



Over the past few years we have had connections with Hungarians living abroad, we could spend some unforgettable days in Croatia, Sub-Carpathia, Transylvania and in Upper Hungary. Some pupils also had possibilities to take school trips to England, Germany and Austria to improve their language skills.

Protecting our Environment

In our school we pay great attention to the environment: we collect recycling paper twice a year, dangerous batteries and used cooking oil are also collected and transported by a recycling company. To motivate the students in this really important issue, the most enthusiastic „collectors” get rewards and gifts for their efforts. Besides Móra supports eco-friendly forms of transport: a safe bike shed can be found in our school and we also organize bicycle tour or cycling camp.

Guinness Record (29-04-2010)

We were building the biggest train made of recycling stuffs for more than 16 hours. The whole school collaborated to build up the huge sculpture. Needless to say that we are pleased with the result. Móra has set the world record. After the hard work we celebrated the success and many reporters published our victory.

Sport Fans

To achieve our goals different healthy programmes are built in the free time activities: we have clubs like handball, soccer, basketball, floorball, cycling, roller-skating and table-tennis. 200 of our students are members of other local sport clubs. Being an open school, we are able to ensure the opportunity of exercises for parents, grandparents or graduated students... etc.





In summer our sport camps in Tata and in Kемence have been popular for yeas. In winter teachers, parents and students have spent an amazing week together in a ski camp.
