

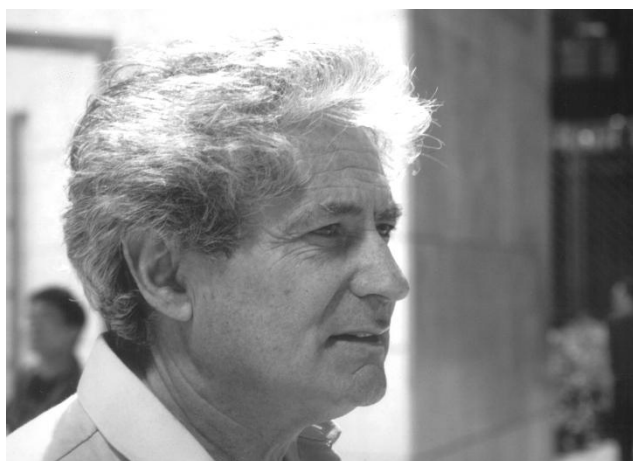

The **ICOMOS Hungarian National Committee** as the Hungarian section of the most important international professional organization of monument protection, from the beginning has regard it's **most important task to contribute to the further education and widening the up to date knowledge of those professionals who deal with protected monuments.**

The **Andás Román Summer University on Monument Protection** is an important event in realization of the above mentioned objective. In the frame of this unique, wide-spread professional further education and international forum has a special regional importance. It is an internationally known and recognized further education. The participating professionals represent all fields of monument protection and the curricula based on the newest Hungarian and international research results, enlighten and discuss various issues of practice. 2016 will be already the 46th years of the summer course. The each year changing theme deals with the current range of the topics of monument and cultural heritage protection. It means **direct professional support for those who are working on research work, restoration, or on the field of protection and presentation as those, who are working on continuous maintenance and repair**, as it happened during the more than four and a half decades. The programme in 2016 will serve these purposes as well. The title is:

TASKS OF RESTORATION – DEMANDS OF SOCIETY

The protection, conservation and restoration of monuments is a team work. In the process of restoration have equal important role the representatives of different professions – representatives of authorities, researchers, architects, restorers, contractors etc. -, as the owners and managers, and also the changing demands and requirements. As the protected heritage broaden and changing in time and space, the usefulness and utilization gained more and more importance. As a consequence of these the values could be often lost. Finding the sensitive balance and harmonizing the demand and the responsibilities are the tasks and duties of the interested parties. The programme of the summer course in 2016 is going to provide theoretical basis and technical assistance for those, who will be present.

The realization of successful preservation and managing of monuments and sites means sophisticated many-figured task. We are going to analyse the phenomenon of monuments restoration from theoretical, scientific and practical point of view. Our aim is to demonstrate the tasks and examine the theoretical and technical bottom of efficient restoration of historic monuments with an international outlook. At the same time we would like to analyse the changing - economic and social – demands of the society, as well as the new methods of the co-operations of the interested parties. Understanding the problems and acquaintance with the adequate practical solutions will be helped by series of Hungarian and foreign case studies. In 2016 the manifold tasks and necessity of the co-operation between professionals and the society will be approaching from theory and practise. The wide range of subjects will be embedded in historical and social milieu. The comprehensive, professional restoration, the well maintained original, or the well-defined new function, sustainability and the new demands will be the part of the programme. The understanding of principles and theories will be assured by the excellent Hungarian and foreign lecturers. **The duration of the lectures 40-45 minutes**

- *The participants are helped to solve their everyday tasks with the **summary like presentations about theory and series of case studies** as well.*
- *We will have habitual **debates, forum-like programmes, workshops and site visits guided by responsible professionals.***
- *At the traditional and very successful **Student's Forum** the students will be able to give account of the results of their own work and experiences **contributing the international audience to the exchange of professional experiences.***
- *The aim of the traditional **one-day study tour to the region and half day visit to the historic city of Eger** to give the possibility of the participants to acquaint with, evaluate and draw the lessons of the cases discussed, with help of professionals concerned.*

In the field of architecture and historic monument protection the summer university is an exceptional opportunity of further and life-long education, acknowledged in Hungary and abroad, too, which intends to throw light upon the possibilities for solutions and upon the scope of action of decision makers, professionals, owners, local government and also committed civilians. The students of this further education represent almost all fields of monument protection profession, and we can regularly greet professionals from different countries of Europe, and also from other continents from South America to Africa, or from Japan to India. It is an additional merit of this event to invite professionals from neighbouring countries who deal with heritage protection also connected to Hungarian identity.

The summer course is accepted as an accredited training and is approved by Budapest Technical University, by Raymond Lemaire International Centre for Conservation of the Catholic University of Leuven. The participants were awarded 9 credit points in the optional category by accreditation committee of the Chamber of Hungarian Architects in 2015.

Simultaneous translation in English is provided all through period of the international summer course. The file of presentation and the illustrations are archived in order to make a bilingual multimedia publication. The already released publications have ISSN and ISBN number in the register of the National Széchenyi Library, and can also be found on the website of the summer university.
